Key Reproductive Health Indicators

- Women of reproductive age (WRA)
- # of unintended pregnancies
- Birth rates (teens and adults)
- Contraceptive prevalence
 - Method mix
- Women of reproductive age in need of contraception

Availability of and Barriers to Services

- Availability of publicly funded programs
- # of female contraceptive clients served by publicly funded programs
 - Impact of publicly funded contraceptive services (women and teens)
- Availability of youth friendly services
- Barriers to services (including LARCs) and patient preferred contraceptive method
 - Barriers to youth services and LARCs
